4. FIRST AID MEASURES

5. FIREFIGHTING MEASURES

Specific Hazards: Do not use a solid water stream as it may scatter and spread fire. Do not allow run-off from firefighting to enter drains or water courses.

PPE and Precautions: Firefighters should wear NIOSH/MSHA approved self-contained breathing apparatus and full protective clothing. Use water-spray to cool fire exposed surfaces and personnel. Product dissolves in water.

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6. ACCIDENTAL RELEASE MEASURES
