PRODUCT INFORMATION

ADVERSARY is intended for use with products registered for agricultural, forestry, industrial, non-cropland, rights of way and other uses. ADVERSARY is used as a spray adjuvant to improve deposition of spray droplets. ADVERSARY improves spreading and reduces the production of fine droplets which are susceptible to movement from the spray pattern.

FIRST AID

If in eyes: Hold eye open and rinse slowly and gently with water for 15 to 20 minutes. Remove contact lenses, if present, after the first 5 minutes, then continue rinsing eye. Call a poison control center or doctor for treatment advice.

If on skin or clothing: Take off contaminated clothing. Rinse skin immediately with plenty of water for 15-20 minutes. Call a poison control center or doctor for treatment advice.

If swallowed: Call a poison control center or doctor immediately for treatment advice. Have a person sip a glass of water if able to swallow. Do not induce vomiting unless told to do so by the poison control center or doctor. Do not give anything by mouth to an unconscious person. If Inhaled: Move person to fresh air. DIRECTIONS FOR USE

Not for Aquatic Use

Read and follow all pesticide label directions.

Use only if a methylated seed oil and nonionic surfactant is allowed or not excluded on the label.

Use caution when applying during hot, dry conditions.

If the user does not have experience with the mixture being applied, perform a jar test using the order and amounts in the mixture to determine compatibility and perform a phytotoxicity test to ensure crop safety.

Prior to mixing, fill the spray tank with half of the carrier. Start the sprayer and check to make sure that all valves and gauges work and that there is adequate tank agitation.

MIXING INSTRUCTIONS

Add pesticides and/or fertilizers as directed by the label or in the following sequence:

- (1) Micronutrients and fertilizers,
- (2) Dry flowables and dispersible granules.
- (3) Flowables.
- (4) Water soluble pesticides,
- (5) Emulsifiable concentrates.

Continue agitation and add *ADVERSARY*. When completed, reduce agitation, and allow to mix for 1 to 2 minutes. While under minimal agitation, continue filling tank and allow to mix for 10-15 minutes prior to application.

USE RATES

Ground or Aerial: 1 to 2 quarts per 100 gallons or 0.25% -0.5 % v/v.

Some pesticides have stated adjuvant use rates. In all cases, the pesticide manufacturer's label should be consulted regarding specific adjuvant use recommendations and that rate followed. Do not add this product at a level that would exceed 5% v/v of the finished spray solution volume unless otherwise specified by the pesticide label.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Storage: Store in a cool, dry place. Store in original container only. Do not store near fire, flame or other potential sources of ignition. Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal of this product. **STORE ABOVE 40°F.**
