GENERAL: TUFF TRAX® is a superior foam marker consisting of a unique blend of ingredients for producing thick, long-lasting foam. TUFF TRAX has been formulated to work over a wide range of water hardness, mineral content and impurities. TUFF TRAX foam should be deposited to the ground in large blobs rather than in narrow streaks; this sometimes may necessitate increasing the diameter of the hose extending from the end of the boom.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE: Foam generating equipment should be cleaned with an agricultural cleaner (i.e., Tank & Equipment Cleaner) before introducing TUFF TRAX. Bottom fill tanks - add TUFF TRAX to clean water at the start of filling. For top filling - TUFF TRAX should be added to clean water when tank is 1/2 full. The fill hose should be below the water level until filling is completed. The air pressure (15-35 psi) should be adjusted to produce thick, fine bubble foam. TUFF TRAX is to be mixed with water at approximately 1% of concentration. Rate: 2 to 3 pints (1.0 to 1.5 litres) TUFF TRAX in 30 to 40 gallons (100 to 150 litres) of water. Should foam produced be too thick, reduce the amount of TUFF TRAX added to the water in the next mix. If foam produced is thin, soft or watery, increase the amount of TUFF TRAX used. If foam consistency is poor, check for a malfunction or contamination in the foam generating system.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

STORAGE: Store in a well-ventilated space. Keep cool. Store in original container. Keep tightly closed. Do not reuse empty container.

DISPOSAL: Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal. Dispose of contents/container on-site or at an approved waste disposal facility. Triple rinse (or equivalent) adding rinse water to spray tank. Offer container for recycling or dispose of container in sanitary landfill, or by other procedures approved by appropriate authorities. Recycling decontaminated containers is the best option of container disposal. The Agricultural Container Recycling Council (ACRC) operates the national recycling program.
